The Town of Didsbury Council held a Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday, November 25, 2025 in Council Chambers.

## Presentations


Council heard presentations from:

- STARS, requesting funding from Council for their operations in the Didsbury and the surrounding area in the amount of \$5,070.
- The Didsbury Lions Club, requesting funding from Council for their operation of the Lions Bus in the amount of \$13,676.00
- The Town of Didsbury Library Board, presenting their proposed budget as well as a request for funding in the amount of \$282,357.00
- The Didsbury & District Historical Society, requesting funding that supports their annual operations in the amount of \$46,500.00 as well as emergency support for the replacement of their boiler.

## Didsbury Show N' Shine Road Closure

The Town has received a road closure request for the Didsbury Show and Shine 2026 – 2029. The approved road closure would be in effect from 6:00 p.m. on Friday before Mother's Day until 4:00 p.m. on the following Saturday – totaling 22 hours.

- 22 Avenue from 21 Street to 20 Street
- 21 Avenue from 21 Street to 20 Street
- 20 Avenue from 21 Street to 19 Street
- 19 Avenue from 21 Street to 20 Street
- 18 Avenue from 21 Street to 20 Street
- 17 Avenue from 21 Street to 20 Street
- 20 Street from 15 Avenue to 23 Avenue
- 19 Street from 15 Avenue to 20 Avenue

Council approved the use of the old high school lands by the Didsbury & District Historical Society for the 2026 Canada Day event, scheduled for July 1, 2026.

## Didsbury Farm & Ranch Bonspiel

The 30th Annual Didsbury Farm & Ranch Bonspiel is scheduled for January 5-10, 2026 at the Didsbury Curling Rink. This annual event draws farmers, business people and visitors to our community each year for lots of exciting curling action, great meals and community connections. Council approved sponsorship for the 2026 Didsbury Farm and Ranch Bonspiel in the amount of \$1,000.00, to be funded from the 2025 Community Grant fund.

## Regular Council Meeting

Council approved the amendment to the 2025-2026 Regular Council Meeting Calendar and move the December 9, 2025 Regular Council Meeting to Monday, December 15, 2025 at 5:00 p.m.

## Strategic Transportation Infrastructure Program (STIP) Application

Council approved the support of the STIP – Resource Road Program application for a joint project for 23 Street and Township Road 314 with a funding model of 50% provincial funding and 50% funding from partner municipalities and third parties.
