



# COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

July 12, 2022

The Town of Didsbury Council held a Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday July 12, 2022, in Council Chambers, 1606 – 14 Street.

- The Policy and Governance Committee reviewed and made recommendations regarding the Council Professional Development Policy COUN 001-22, and the Council Remuneration Policy COUN 004-22. Revised policies were approved by Council.
- Council awarded the 2022 Concrete Repair and Maintenance contract to Olds Concrete, in the amount of \$106, 268.97.
- Council approved the sole source award, provided by Read On Roads, for improvement to the 23 Street corridor between the CPR spur line and the CPR mainline, for a cost of \$150,000.00 to be funded from the General Reserve.
- Council appointed MNP LLP as auditor for the Town of Didsbury for the 2022-2024 fiscal years, with the option to renew for 2025 and 2026.
- Council approved the recommendation of the Performance Evaluation Committee, in response to the closure of the compost bin, for a one-time \$50.00 rebate program for backyard composters to be offered, by the Town of Didsbury, for composters purchased at local Didsbury businesses only. Additionally, Council approved a summer fee discount to be offered to residents wanting additional green bins. For the remainder of the green bin season, 2022, residents may add additional green bins for a one-time administration fee of \$15/bin, and a monthly collection fee of \$3/additional bin.
- Council approved weather proofing work for the old fire hall, up to \$15,000, to be funded from the Economic Development Reserve. Discussion regarding the future use of the resource will be referred to the strategic planning process in the Fall.
